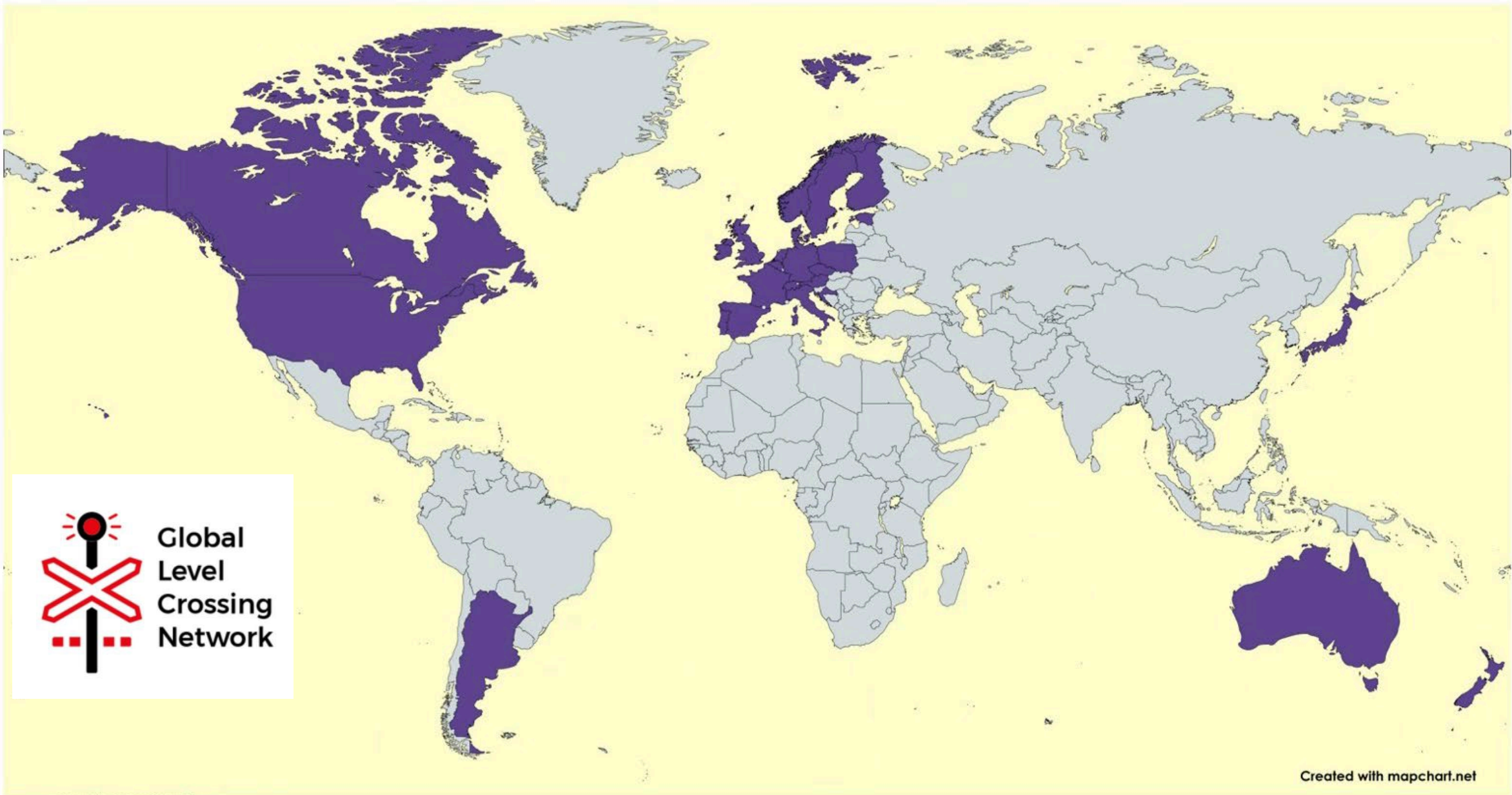

UIC Best practice for grade crossing risk assessment



- 1 Risk assess each individual crossing
- 2 The frequency of re-assessment should be guided by the risk at each crossing
- 3 Look beyond the level crossing
- 4 Think like the user
- 5 Engage with users and stakeholders
- 6 The numbers are useful, but they are not everything
- 7 Eliminate, Reduce, Control, Inform, Educate
